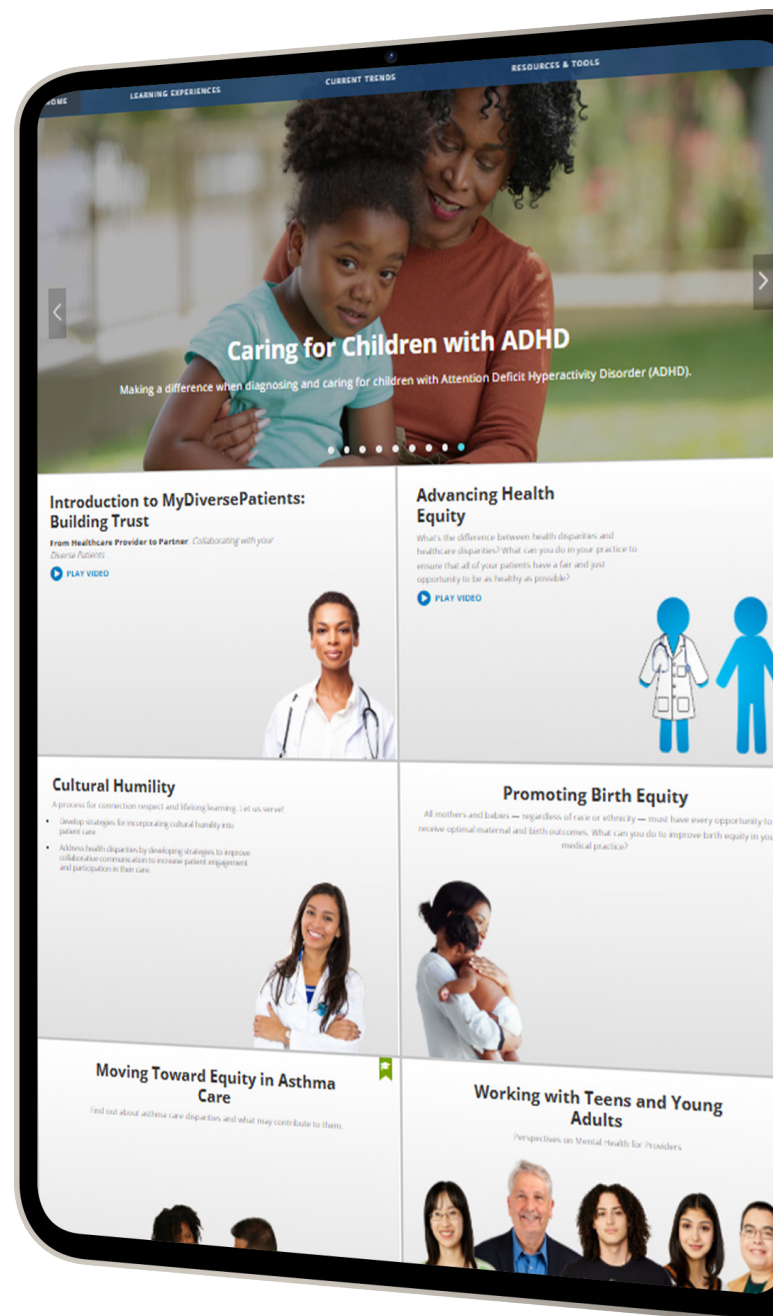

Measure	Updated health disparity statistics (2025) Latest CDC/NIH-supported Update
Hypertension	African American adults continue to have the highest prevalence of hypertension in the U.S. NHANES 2017–2020 estimates: ~57% of African American men and ~61% of African American women have hypertension.
Infant mortality	2023 infant mortality: 10.93 deaths per 1,000 live births for non-Hispanic African American mothers versus about 4.5 per 1,000 for non-Hispanic White mothers.
Diabetes	CDC now reports race/ethnicity disparities through the U.S. Diabetes Surveillance System. Hispanics continue to experience disproportionately high diabetes prevalence, complications, and mortality.
LGBTQ+ youth	Recent CDC Youth Risk Behavior Survey data show about 45% of LGBTQ+ high school students seriously considered suicide and about 22% attempted suicide in the previous year.

White alone	74.3%
White alone, not Hispanic or Latino	56.1%
Black or African American alone	13.5%
Hispanic or Latino (any race)	20.5%
Asian alone	6.9%
American Indian & Alaska Native alone	2.1%
Native Hawaiian & Other Pacific Islander alone	0.3%
